

## Hard Fail vs Soft Fail

A hard fail means the field is required in order for the applicant to be able to submit.

This could mean that the Net ID has to be verified, the preferred name is required, or other required items such as statement of intent, recommender names and emails, supplemental materials uploaded, transcript uploads.

A soft fail means it is a warning that this could be a potential issue in the application but does not stop submission.

Examples include: low English test scores, missing endorsement, etc.
