

BYU Endorsement Site – Member Endorsement Process

Member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints:

Steps:

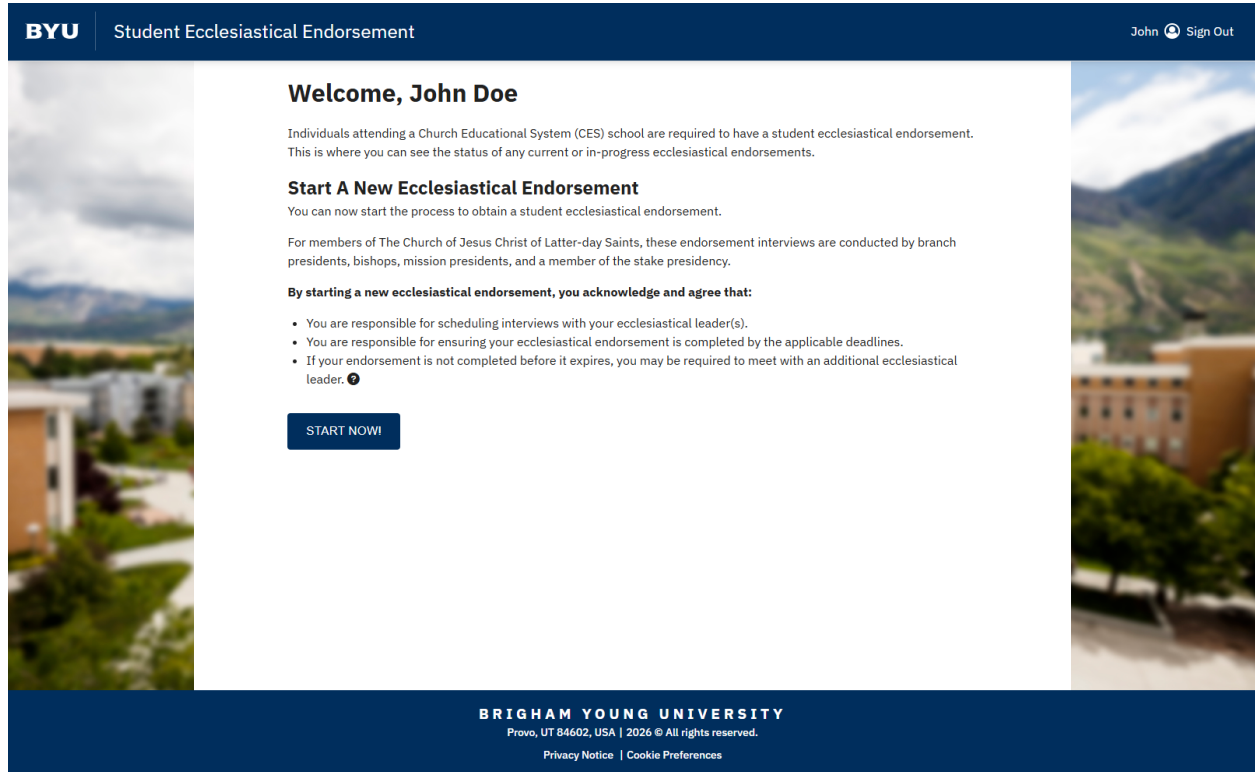
- If you do *not* have a current (active) endorsement, see **A. No Active Endorsement.**
- If your endorsement has expired, see **B. No Active Endorsement, Expired.**
- If you have a current endorsement that is *not* in a renewal period, see **C. Active Endorsement.**
- If you have a current endorsement, but are in the renewal period, see **D. Active Endorsement, In Renewal Period.**

If you are getting an ecclesiastical endorsement for the first time, or your previous ecclesiastical endorsement has expired, you will likely need two interviews to complete the process. Otherwise, you will likely only need one interview (renewal).

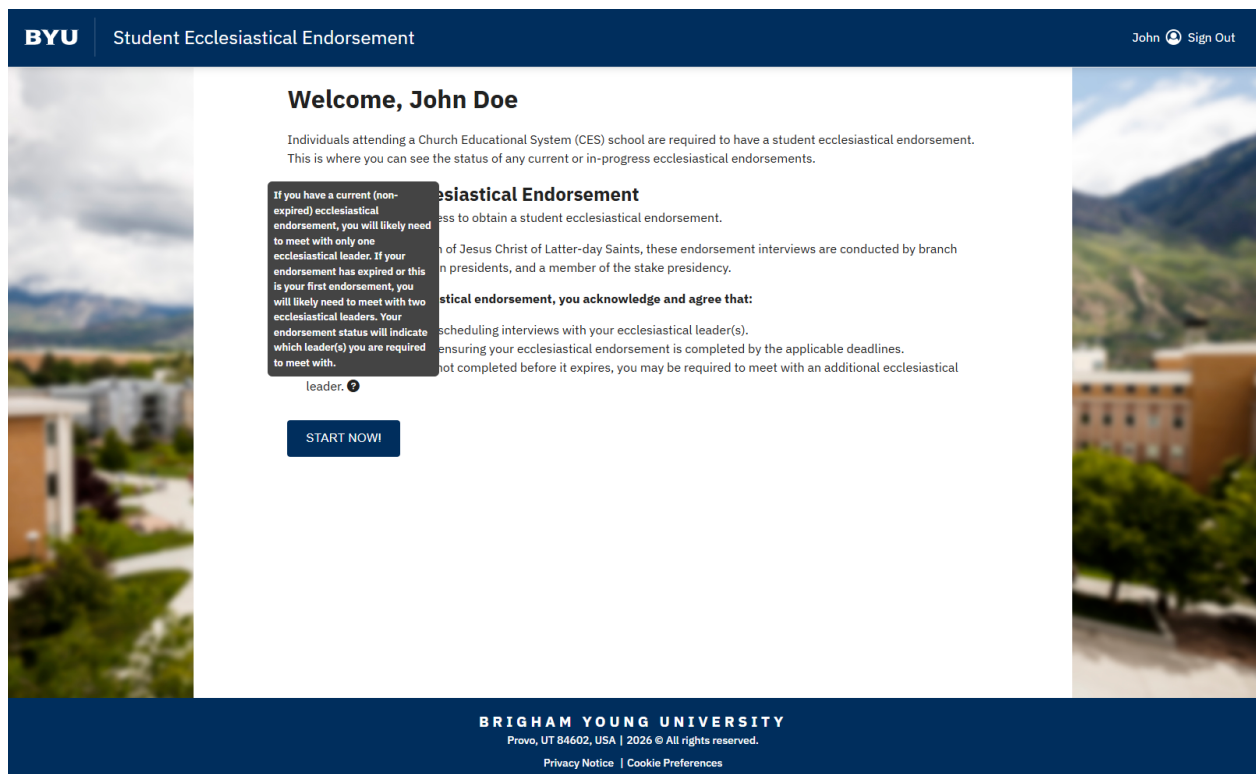
