

Hard Fail vs. Soft Fail

A hard fail occurs when a required field is incomplete, preventing the applicant from submitting.

This could mean the Net ID must be verified, the preferred name is required, or other required items such as a statement of intent, recommender names and emails, uploaded supplemental materials, transcript uploads, etc.

A soft fail warns that this could be an issue in the application but does not stop submission.

Examples include low English test scores, missing endorsement, etc.
